DESCRIPTIONS FOR FACE-TO-FACE OR VIRTUAL LEARNING OPTIONS ARE BELOW, IF OUR REGION IS IN PHASES 4-6.

FACE-TO-FACE OPTION

- **K-12 Students will be required to wear a mask on the bus.**
- **Grades K-5 – (Students will remain with his/her classroom cohort.)**
 - Masks required in the hallway
 - Students will NOT be required to wear masks in classroom, during lunch, during recess
 - Enhanced cleaning and hand washing throughout the day
 - Robust and supportive face-to-face learning environment
 - Social/Emotional Learning and Support
- **Grades 6th – 12th**
 - Masks will be required during the school day (In hallways, classrooms, and bathrooms)
 - Students will NOT be required to wear masks during breakfast/lunch while seated and eating
 - Enhanced cleaning and hand washing throughout the day
 - Robust and supportive face-to-face learning environment
 - Social/Emotional Learning and Support
 - Vocational Education Face-to-Face
 - Extracurricular opportunities (If permitted)

GRADES K-5 VIRTUAL LEARNING

- **Families will be able to sign up for virtual learning.**
 - Minimum commitment (One Marking Period)
 - Robust, enhanced and supportive virtual learning experience
 - Students enrolled virtually will be following the same curriculum as students attending in person
 - Internet access is necessary
 - Attendance will be taken
 - Daily required meeting time
 - Skills will be assessed and scored on student's report card
 - Demonstration of skills will be required to continue advancing
 - At home adult support and guidance will be required
 - Teachers will check in with parents multiple times per week to discuss student progress
 - Social/Emotional Learning and Support
 - Extracurricular opportunities (If permitted)
 - Remain a St. Louis Public Schools student and eligible for all opportunities provided to face-to-face students
 - Packaged breakfast and lunch available for pick-up

GRADES 6-12 VIRTUAL LEARNING

- **Families will be able to sign up for virtual learning.**
 - Minimum commitment (One Marking Period)
 - Robust, enhanced and supportive virtual learning experience
 - Students enrolled virtually will be following the same curriculum as students attending in person
 - Internet access is necessary
 - Attendance will be taken
 - Daily required meeting time
 - Skills will be assessed and scored on student's report card. (Letter grades will be earned)
 - Demonstration of skills will be required to continue advancing
 - Adult support and guidance will be necessary
 - Teachers will check in with parents and/or students multiple times per week to discuss student progress
 - Social/Emotional Learning and Support
 - Grades 11-12 would be permitted to attend vocational classes face-to-face (No virtual option for vocational classes) Transportation will be available
 - Extracurricular opportunities (If permitted)
 - Remain a St. Louis Public Schools student and eligible for all opportunities provided to face-to-face students
 - Packaged breakfast and lunch available for pick-up

Face to Face Learning

- *Teachers provide direct instruction to students**
- *Face-to- Face Interaction and feedback**
- *Immediate feedback on instructional strategies**
- *Verbal/body language cues**
- *Whole & small group instruction**
- *Student collaboration time**
- *Physical meeting space**

***In both learning environments, teachers guide learning, communicate with students, monitor assessments, and develop course content.**



Virtual Learning

- *Teachers provide interactive digital learning and instruction for students**
- *Individualized and paced instruction**
- *Students need to be self-directed and have structured time management**
- *Assignments and assessments submitted virtually**
- *Virtual meetings with teachers**
